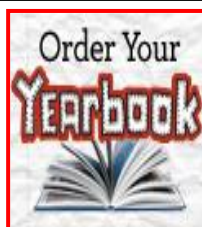
Kindergarten Registration

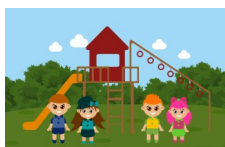

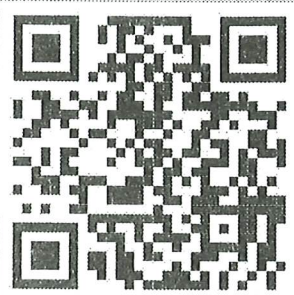
